
Zyrardów

Żyrardów, a Polish city founded in 1833 as a textile centre, is known for preserving its old 19th century factories and adapting them to modern requirements. The town is 10 kilometers from Puszcza Mariańska, a forest protected by tree-cutting laws.

In the city you can find an eco-park that was built to disconnect people from technology and from the daily life.

You can also find Reco Mat in shops, machines that let you return glass and plastic bottles that you used and you can earn a little amount of money.

Common public fridges are settled around the city to save leftovers.
